### FAITH VENTURES

In June, Judy & I will be, Lord willing, traveling to new ground in the Far East of Russia and some “Stan” countries. We have incredibly dedicated workers who are requesting our presence for a period of teaching and encouragement. The plan is to travel with another co-worker and his wife from our U.S. office. New opportunities are opening in the remotest areas of Russia.

There are 6.5 million people in an area the size of the USA with only 45 churches. We plan to establish a new ministry center in Khabarovsk and 12 locations with a plane allowing travel to the remotest villages. Our partners at Kingdom Air Corps in Alaska are providing the aviation arm of this outreach.
